UNV is currently looking for professional and highly motivated individuals, with a genuine concern for global issues, interested to serve as UN Volunteers with UN agencies as well as UN peacekeeping operations.

UN Volunteers serve in many areas; specific future assignments are expected in:

• Health (in this area, at least 2 years of clinical experience is required)

- such as medical doctors, including specialists such as obstetricians and gynecologists;
 anesthesiologists; surgeons; cardiologists; orthopedists; urologists; pediatricians;
 traumatologists, endocrinologists; ophthalmologists etc.
- o medical doctors specialized in public health.
- Staff counselors and clinical psychologists
- Midwives and nurses

• Substantive functions (in this area, at least 2 years of relevant experience plus mostly experience in the field is required)

- o Monitoring and evaluation specialists
- o Human Rights specialists
- o Child Protection specialist
- o Resettlement/Reintegration/Repatriation Refugee Status Determination officer
- o Programme development and project management specialists

Technical and support areas

- o such as aviation, movement/transport control,
- engineering (e.g. civil engineering, mechanics), procurement, logistics, water and sanitation specialists

Please keep in mind that while the term "Volunteers" is used, the following assistance is provided:

- Settling-in-Grant calculated on the duration of assignment, which is paid at the beginning of the assignment;
- Volunteer Living Allowance (VLA) (not a salary) intended to cover basic living expenses, which is paid each month;
- Travel on appointment and at the end of assignment as applicable;
- · Life, health and permanent disability insurance;
- Annual leave;
- Resettlement allowance calculated based on the duration of assignment, which is paid upon satisfactory completion of the assignment.

Attached is further information on the UNV programme including the minimum requirements, as well as instructions on how to register and update your profile. To increase your chances of being considered for UNV assignments, you must ensure that you take the time to fill in all the required information online as soon as you register, otherwise you may be screened out on the basis of the incomplete information provided. Please note that the duration of UN Volunteer assignments can be an initial contract of 6 months, generally with a possibility to extend for 1 - 2 years.
